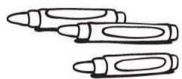




HERO BALL

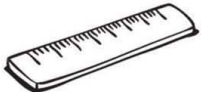
You will need:



colours



scissors



ruler



glue



string



20 circles for
each ball



STEP 1 – print or draw the circles.

STEP 2 – colour in the heroes from the Hero in my Hood story activity books.

Look online at the books and find the names of our heroes.

Write their name in their circle.

STEP 3 – there are 2 blank circles.

Draw a picture of yourself in one.

Draw a picture of your hero in the other.

STEP 4 – cut out all 20 circles.

STEP 5 – fold them along the dotted lines.

TIP: place a ruler on the dotted line and fold the flap up against the ruler.

STEP 6 – glue the flaps of the folded circles together – 5 circles to a point.

STEP 7 – attach some string to your ball and hang it up.

There is a page of blank circles.

Print out 20 circles.

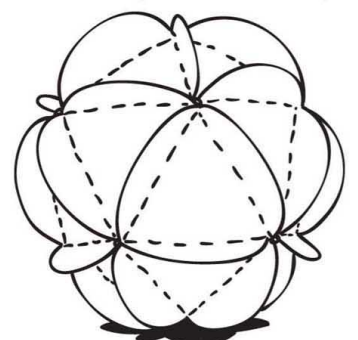
Draw your own pictures of your family, friends and heroes in these circles.

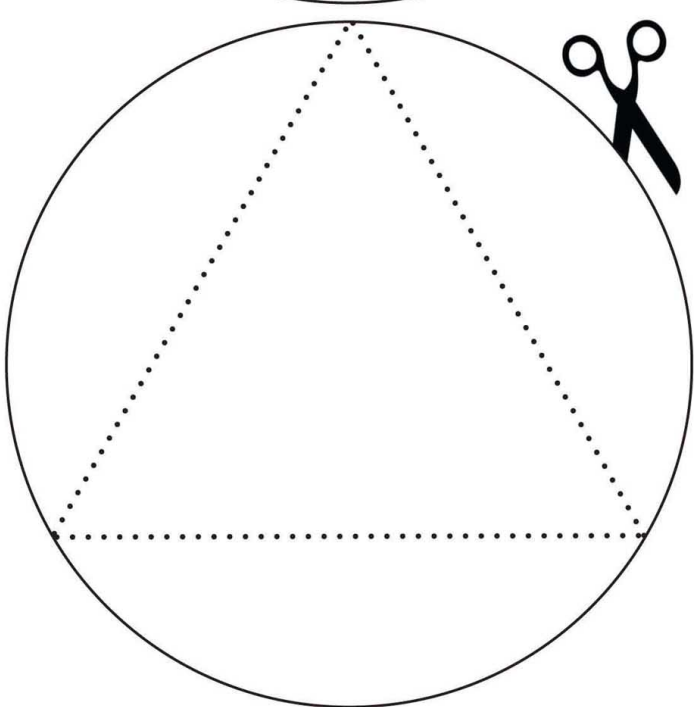
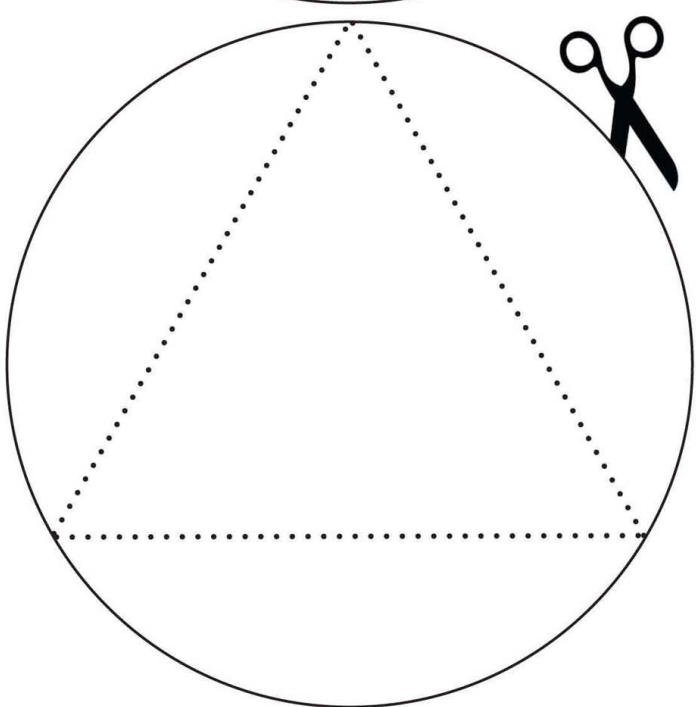
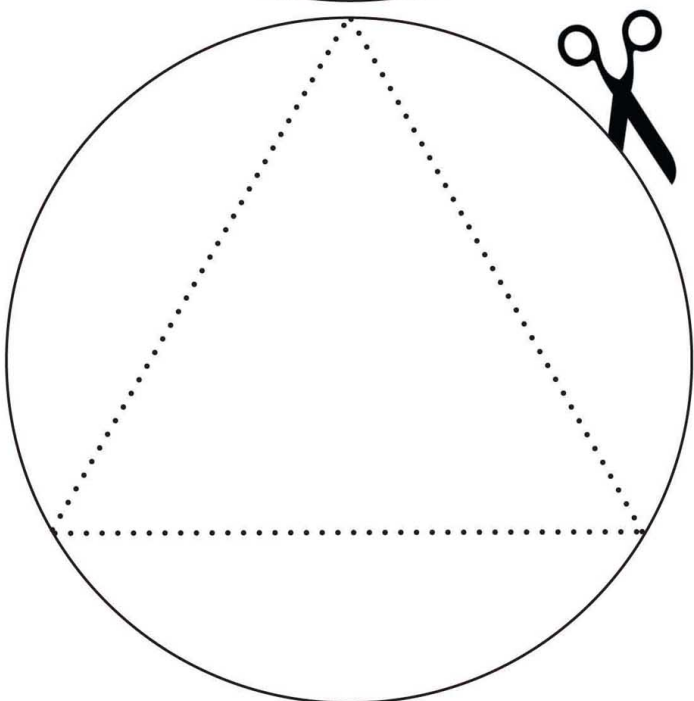
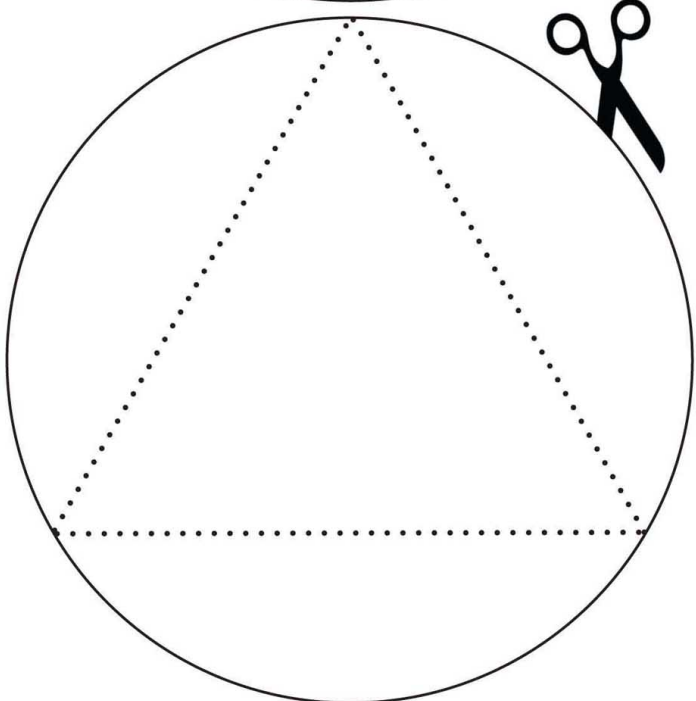
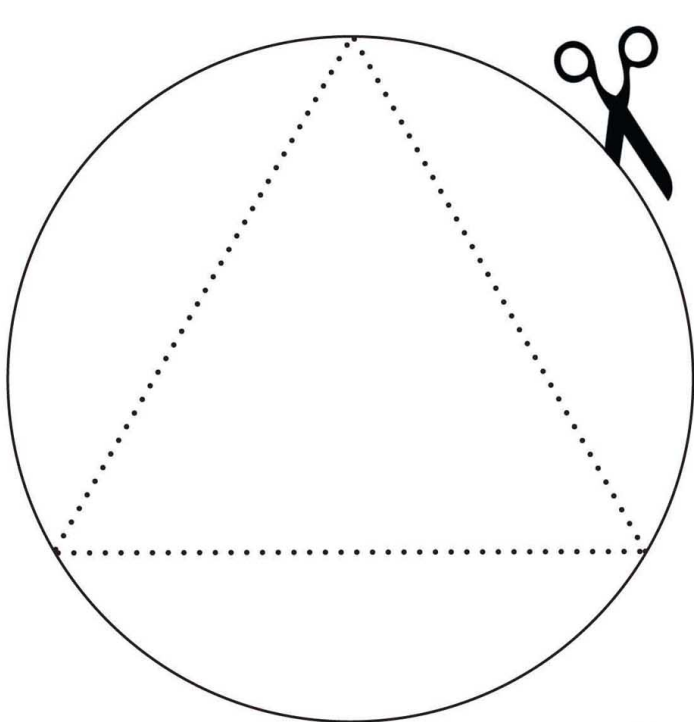
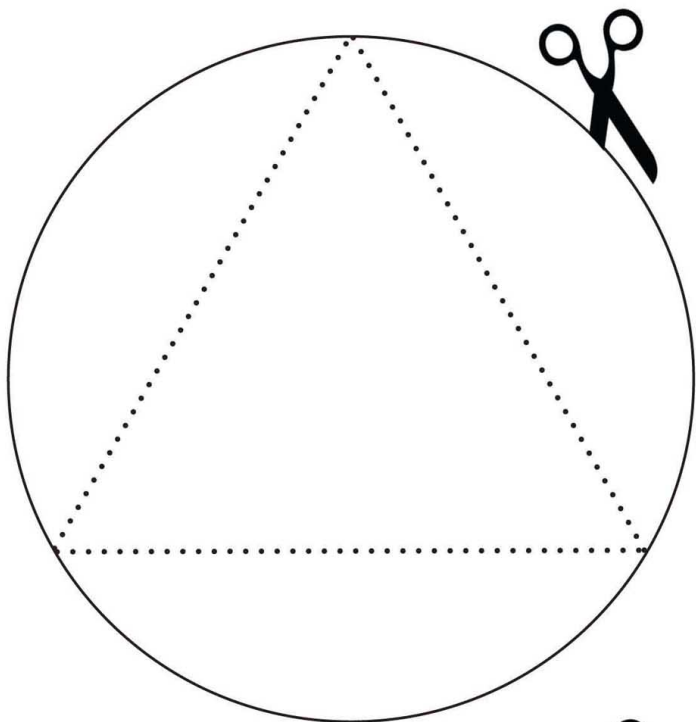
OR
