You will need:



scissors



soap



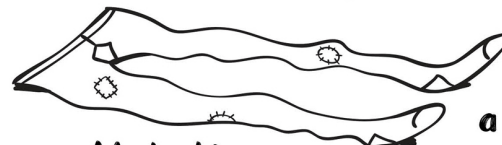
wire



a bottle



string

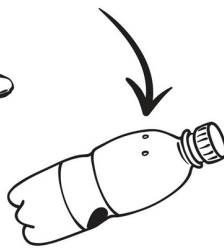


old stockings

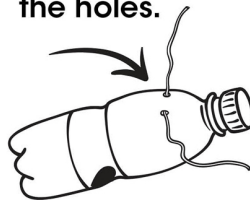


a stick

1.
Make 2 holes
at the back
of the bottle
near the top.



2.
Push the wire
through
the holes.



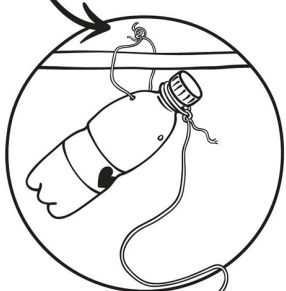
3.
Make a hole
in the
middle of the
front of the
bottle,
also near
the top.



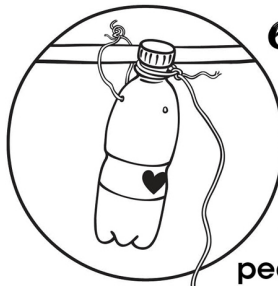
4.
Tie the
string
around the
neck of the
bottle.

Tip: cut the string long enough
to reach the ground from
where you choose to hang
your tap.

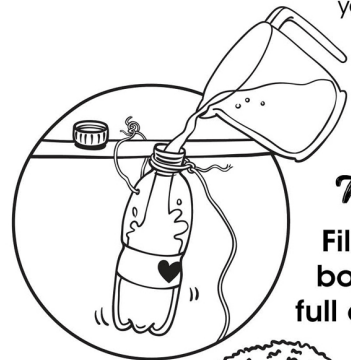
5.
Hang the bottle by twisting the
wire loosely around something
like a fence, a gate
or a branch.



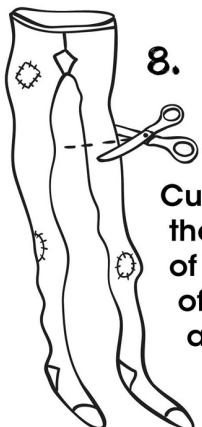
6.
Tie the stick
to the end
of the
string, to
make a
pedal.



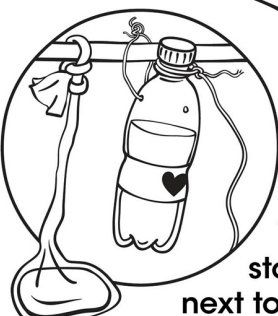
7.
Fill the
bottle half
full of water.



8.
Cut off
the leg
of an old pair
of stockings,
and put the
bar of soap
inside.



9.
Tie the
stocking
next to your
bottle.



10.
Push down on the pedal,
your tap will tip and the
water will come out!



Tip: instead of stockings you can use
a net bag or just tie string around the soap.
