

## TEACH CHILDREN: When crossing the road ...












Cross the street at a corner, a crosswalk or where you can see the road clearly.



Make sure driver can see you.



Walk on the pavement or walk as far from the road as you can.

Play in a safe area away from cars.





Watch for vehicles that might turn or reverse.

At night walk on well-lit roads and wear bright visable clothes.



Children under 10 years should not walk on the street alone.
