

Teach your dog to SIT



- **4.** Move your hand with the treat slowly above the dog's head so that it will start to tilt backwards. Keep your hand quite close to the head. Say the word "SIT" as you move your hand so your dog learns the word.
- 5. As your dog watches your hand, its bottom will move down towards the ground. When you see its bottom touch the ground, say: "YES"

TIP

Some dogs may jump up to get the treat. If this happens, we often move our hand higher and the dog jumps more. After showing the dog the treat, close it in your hand and keep your hand low over the dog's head so that it does not need to jump.



Be patient. If it is not working, take a break and try again later. We all learn at different paces and leaning takes time.
